Time and Proximity Factors

(Part II)

1. FERRIE AND OSWALD

In a note written shortly before he died DAVID FERRIE indicates, as one of the persons to be notified of his death, the name BRUCE NOLAN. The phone book indicates that B. H. NOLAN (who resides at 2824 State Street) works for the telephone company at 1215 Prytania. The phone book also indicates a H. A. NOLAN at 5401 Elmeer Place in Metairie. It is to be noted that JOHN C. OSWALD, JR. works for the telephone company at 1215 Prytania. It is to be noted further that LOWELL OSWALD (who has an insurance business at 802 Perdido, near Camp Street) resides at 132 Elmeer Place and that W. J. OSWALD (whose name LEE OSWALD also uses in references) resides at 136 Elmeer Place.

2. RABEL AND OSWALD

LOUIS RABEL, the head of the Cuban Liberation Democratic Front (as of approximately January, 1962) lived at that time in the 5100 block of Burgundy Street. The phone book indicates that JOHN C. OSWALD, SR. (the father of the JOHN OSWALD described above) lives at 5236 Burgundy Street.

3. OSWALD, ALBA AND NOVEL

JOHN OSWALD, JR. lives at 605 Focis. ADRIAN ALBA (whose office was next to the REILY Coffee Company) and was the place where LEE OSWALD spent much of his time away from his job) lives at 624 Focis Street. It is to be noted that among the clients of ADRIAN ALBA'S garage are reported to be vehicles of the U.S. Post Office and the U.S. Treasury Department. It is further noted that GORDON NOVEL once had a garage on Focis, and it was in this garage that a car which he and RANCIER EHLINGER were charged with stealing, was kept.

4. EHLINGER, ALBA AND KENNEDY

Homestead Avenue is two blocks from Elmeer in Metairie. RANCIER EHLINGER lives at 103 Homestead Avenue. CHESTER ALBA, a relative of ADRIAN ALBA'S, lives at 339 Homestead Avenue. REGIS KENNEDY lives at 523 Homestead Avenue. REGIS KENNEDY is the FBI agent who was assigned to cover DAVID FERRIE after my office turned FERRIE over to the Bureau for questioning. KENNEDY was a former member of "Friends of Democratic Cuba", an organization which was housed in the International Trade Mart and which numbered among its members at least one CIA agent and at least one friend of CLAY SHAW.

5. It will be recalled that in the previous portion of "Time and Propinquity Factors" it was pointed out that MR. and MRS. H. WARNER (RUTH) KLOEPFER lived at 3033 Louisiana Avenue Parkway, near DAVID FERRIE, and that they had visited LEE OSWALD on several occasions at his Magazine Street home. An examination of apartments owned by CLAY SHAW indicates that WILLIAM KLOEPFER used to reside (at least through the year 1964) in Apartment 1 of 724 Governor Nicholls, which building is owned by CLAY SHAW. WILLIAM KLOEPFER is a research engineering supervisor for the Chrysler Corporation.

6. NOVEL, ANDREWS AND OSWALD

In 1965 NOVEL was a partner (with ROBERT SCOTT, ROBERT SONGE, LOUIS GOMEZ and RANCIER EHLINGER) in "Electronics Systems International Corporation". The notary was DEAN ANDREWS. NOVEL'S company was located in the Perdido Building at 822 Perdido. LOWELL OSWALD'S insurance company is located at 802 Perdido.
